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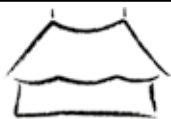
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# **ENTRY RULES - FLOWER & PRODUCE SHOW**

*Classes are open to all exhibitors*

**Please read the rules and schedule carefully**

- All exhibits (excluding the floral art classes) must have been grown or made by the exhibitor and have not been previously entered in the show.
- The entry fee is 50p per entry.
- All entries, accompanied by entrance fees, must be made in writing to: Mrs Aileen Sherer, The Old Brickyard, Lower Brailes, OX15 5AF on Thursday 8th August by 7pm.

The Forge Garage, Lower Brailes and Baldwins Newsagent will also accept entry forms until Thursday 8th August by 5pm.
- Each named entrant must be on a separate entry form in sealed envelopes with the correct fee. Please state age if in the children's section
- NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.
- Any exhibitor may enter more than one exhibit in any class but shall not take more than one monetary prize in that class except where stated.
- Exhibits must be staged on the morning of the show between 8.30am and 10.45am, when the marquee is cleared for judging. The committee will not be responsible for any loss or damage.
- The judges may call in any assistance they require and their decision in all cases is final.
- If there are insufficient entries in any one class one or more prizes may be withheld. The judges are not obliged to award prizes where they think they are not merited.
- The Marquee will open to the public at 1.30pm and close after presentation of the cups.
- No exhibit is to be removed before the completion of the cup presentation.
- All exhibits must be removed at the end of the show and before 5pm.
- Prize money is to be collected between 2.00pm and 4.30pm from the Treasurer. Any prize money not collected will be a donation to the show
- The points for judging will be awarded as follows:
- All classes: 1st: 3 points, 2nd: 2 points, 3rd: 1 point
- In the event of a tie for a cup, the award will go to the exhibitor with the most 1st prizes.

## RECIPES

### **Class 79: Mary Berry's Coffee & Walnut cake (from the Great Sport Relief Bake Off)**

x2 loose-bottomed 20cm/8in sandwich tins

#### **Ingredients**

225g/8oz unsalted butter, softened, plus extra for greasing, 225g/8oz caster sugar, 4 large eggs, 225g/8oz self-raising flour, ½ level tsp baking powder, 1 tbsp coffee granules, dissolved in 1 tbsp of boiling water, 50g/1½oz walnuts, finely chopped

**Filling & Topping** - 125g/4½oz unsalted butter, softened, 225g/8oz icing sugar, sifted, 1 tbsp coffee granules, dissolved in 1 tbsp of boiling water, 8 walnut halves, to decorate.

#### **Method**

Preheat the oven to 180C/160C Fan/Gas 4. Lightly butter two loose-bottomed 20cm/8in sandwich tins and line the bases with baking paper.

Put the butter, sugar, eggs, flour, baking powder and coffee in a large mixing bowl and beat together (using an electric hand whisk if you have one) until well combined and smooth. Fold in the walnuts. Divide the mixture evenly between the tins. Level the surface using a spatula or the back of a spoon.

Bake for 25-28 minutes, or until an inserted skewer comes out clean. Leave the cakes to cool in the tins for 5 minutes, then run a small palette knife or rounded butter knife around the edge of the tins and carefully turn the cakes out onto a wire rack. Peel off the paper and leave to cool completely. For the filling and topping, beat the butter and gradually add the icing sugar. Add the coffee and beat until smooth.

Choose the cake with the best top, then put the other cake upside-down onto a serving plate and spread with half the coffee icing. Sandwich together with the other half. Ice the top of the cake and decorate with the walnut pieces to serve.

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### **Class 85: An Almond, Rosemary & Courgette Cake**

18cm square tin, loose bottomed greased & lined with baking parchment

#### **Ingredients**

300g (about 2 medium-sized) courgettes, trimmed and grated, 50ml olive oil, plus extra for greasing, 130g ground almonds, 70g plain flour, 1 tsp baking powder, 3 tbsp finely chopped fresh rosemary, 75g light brown sugar, 2 eggs, 2 lemons, zested and juiced, 1 tbsp icing sugar, for dusting, 150g raspberries, to serve, 250g ricotta, lightly whipped, to serve (optional)

#### **Method**

1. Place the grated courgette in a colander and sprinkle with ½ tsp salt. Toss well, then place over the sink to drain for 30 mins.
2. Preheat the oven to gas 5, 190°C, fan 170°C. Grease a 20cm cake tin with olive oil and line the base with baking paper.
3. In a large bowl, mix together the ground almonds, flour, baking powder, pinch of salt and chopped rosemary. In a separate bowl, whisk together the sugar, oil, eggs and lemon zest and juice.
4. Rinse the courgette to get rid of any excess salt and tip onto a clean tea towel. Squeeze out as much moisture as you can, then tip into the almond bowl and mix well. Add the wet ingredients and stir well to make a smooth batter.
5. Allow the cake to cool in the tin for 5 mins, then remove and cool completely on a wire rack. To serve, dust with the icing sugar before cutting into slices. If serving as a dessert, cut into slices and serve with a scattering of raspberries and a dollop of the whipped ricotta.

Tips: Salting and draining the grated courgette is important for the final texture of the cake, otherwise it may be too soggy as courgettes naturally contain a lot of water.



# HELPFUL HINTS FOR EXHIBITORS

- Read the schedule carefully and fill in your entry form and return by the correct date.
- Note size requirements and restrictions (eg: if it says 4 potatoes then 5 or 6 will not be judged). Make sure you have the correct number.
- Bring exhibits to the marquee between 8.30 and 10.30 on the morning of the Show. Allow yourself time to collect your exhibitor's number and display your exhibits.
- Produce should be staged on your own plates and dishes, trays etc.
- Cut flowers should be in water in your own container.
- Wine bottles should be clean, (no finger marks) and labelled correctly.
- Honey jars clean (no finger marks). Produce jars clean and correct clean lids.
- For craft exhibits, bring your own staging if needed to display the item at its best. Art likewise can be staged.
- Photographs are pinned on boards so should be mounted on card or paper.
- Floral art: niches are provided for most classes.

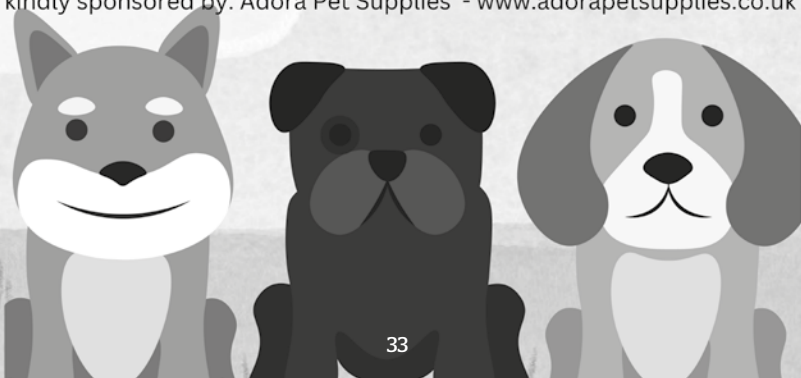

All competitors in all ridden events must be wearing the correct riding clothing (including footwear), otherwise the Committee has the right to refuse entry. Hard hats with a chinstrap should be worn at all times when on horseback, even when not competing.\* See below for Riding Hat requirements\*

Owners entering their horses/ponies do so entirely at their own risk and it is a condition of entry that no liability of any kind attaches itself to Brailes Horse Show or its Committee in any respect whatsoever, other than the liability for the refund of entry fee in the event of abandonment of a competition. In the event of a postponement due to bad weather or any other unforeseen circumstances, no refund of entry fees can be made.

In respect of junior classes where a certain age is specified, proof of age may be necessary. Age to be taken as that on the show date.

All owners and riders (and where applicable, their parents or guardians) of horses/ponies entering any competition in this show will be expected to behave with propriety and to comply with any requests of the officials promptly and without argument. In the case of unseemly behaviour, by word or deed, the Committee reserves the right to disqualify the offender and order him or her to leave the ring. The organisers reserve the right to return or refuse any entry.

The decision of the judges shall be final. Objections of any kind must be made in writing and delivered to the Horse Show Secretary, together with a deposit of £10 for each objection, on the day of the Show. Such objections will be considered by the Brailes Committee and their decision will be final. The deposit will be forfeited if the objection is considered frivolous.

\*We are obliged to follow the recommendations of the Pony Club, relating to riding hats. To compete in this event, competitors must wear a riding hat that complies with one of the following standards or any later standards that may have been subsequently introduced (in addition, body protectors are strongly recommended):

PAS 015 1998 & 2011 with kitemark or Inspec IC mark: VGI with kitemark or Inspec IC mark: ASTM F1163 043a onwards with SEI global mark: SNELL E2001 and E2016: AS/NZS 3838 2006 onwards with SAI global mark.
